***Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.***

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, Group Travel Protection premiums, excess baggage fees, and all other items not specifically mentioned. Any taxes or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of **\$500 per person** is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (**credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form**), including optional group insurance, if applicable, and is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. **There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure.** All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 19-15 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 14-10 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited. *imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$555 for basic itinerary.**

**ITINERARY and CHANGES:** Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed

by the passenger must be provided in writing to **imagine** no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:** Land Only price is \$2695 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 100 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once printed. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers.

**VISAS:** Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. *imagine* is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket

which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** If the tour is cancelled due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees *plus any airline penalties if applicable*. Any cancellation from day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person *plus any airline penalties*, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = **\$500**; 59-45 days = **\$1750**; 44-25 days = **75% of total cost**; 24 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost**. **All Cancellations must be received in writing.** On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. **We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.**

**PASSPORT:** Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport** that has an expiration date at least **six months after the date of return** from their trip. A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 90 days prior to departure.

**STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY:** *Imagine* and its associated companies agree to provide the itinerary described in this brochure. This represents the entire agreement between the passenger and his agent, the travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. All prices, itineraries and schedules are subject to regulations and changes by acts of government, international agreement, and airline tariff adjustments, rules, and regulations. *Imagine* reserves the right to refuse or revoke travel to anyone who is, in the sole judgment of *Imagine*, incapable of group travel. Except for the willful negligence of its direct employees, the tour operator assumes no liability or responsibility for any injuries, inconveniences, illness, irregularity, or incidental damages caused by circumstances beyond the control of the tour operator or by any person or reason whatsoever, including but not limited to events such as strikes, revolts, wars, natural disasters, closures of airports or hotel, default or omission of any common or private carrier, or the fault, negligence, or omission of and by any third party providing services or facilities related to or included in this tour or any part thereof, or in arranging for the same, or the acts or omissions of the travel agent or the tour host.

You understand and freely accept these risks, and you generally and specifically release and hold harmless *imagine* and their officers, agents and employees from any liability and any claims for (i) any physical, mental, emotional or other injuries whatsoever that you may sustain related to this tour; (ii) delays, damages, illness, injuries or death, or for the loss of or damage to property, from any cause (including negligence) and however occurring; and (iii) any accident, illness, injury, damage, sickness, loss of personal property, delay, or other Injury or claim of any kind related to or arising from strikes, armed conflicts, social or labor unrest or strikes/work stoppages, war or acts of war, terrorism or terrorist acts, acts of God, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws or acts of local or government authorities, criminal acts, weather or climatic conditions, volcanic eruption, earthquake, disruption of advertised schedules, refusal of visas, or any other causes beyond their direct control.

**DAY 1 - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14: DEPART U.S.A.**

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel. After dinner is served, sit back and relax, enjoying the on-board entertainment as you prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime – walking where Jesus walked.

**DAY 2 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15: ARRIVE IN TEL AVIV**

In Tel Aviv we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We transfer to our motor coach for a short drive to our hotel in Netanya in time for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 16: CAESAREA, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, NAZARETH, GALILEE**

Today we depart for the Galilee, visiting the following Biblical sites: Caesarea where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman Centurion (Acts 10), Megiddo, and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven (1 Kings 18). Time permitting, we'll stop at the Druze Village for a short lunch break (not included). We drive to Nazareth to visit the "Nazareth Village" with detailed explanation of what life was like during the time of Jesus (Luke 1 & 2). We then arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

**DAY 4 - THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 17: GOLAN HEIGHTS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, JORDAN RIVER**

After breakfast, we travel north for the Golan Heights and view the area from a special lookout. We drive to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made the good confession of Christ as "the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13-16). We have a short hike/walk to Tel Dan where we see the gate of Jeroboam. We return before dark to the Sea of Galilee where you will have the opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River (Additional Cost). We return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 5 - FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 18: GALILEE, MT. OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, BOAT RIDE, BEIT SHEAN, JERUSALEM**

There is nothing like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee from our hotel. Afterwards we make our way to

the Mt. of Beatitudes (Matthew 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. We continue to Capernaum (Jesus' base for His early ministry), then board a replica wooden "Jesus Boat" for our boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Our lunch stop includes the option of ordering the special St. Peter's Fish for those interested (not included). Afterwards we see Gadara, then we visit Beit Shean, one of the best preserved Decapolis Roman cities. In Beit Shean, the bodies of King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls after they were defeated by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12). We then ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem in time for dinner and overnight. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem" (Psalm 122:1-2 NASB).

**DAY 6 - SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 19: EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, MASADA, DEAD SEA FOR SWIM/FLOAT**

After breakfast, we drive to Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul. From here we make our way to Qumran and the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Following the road south along the western shore of the Dead Sea, we visit Masada, ascending the wilderness mountain by way of cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of fortifications, waterworks, the synagogue, temples and palaces. We make a special stop at the Dead Sea (the lowest spot on earth) for a short swim. Time and conditions permitting, we'll include a short visit to Jericho. We continue our drive to Jerusalem. The road from the Dead Sea area to Jerusalem is an

ascent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

**DAY 7 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 20: MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, JEWISH QUARTER, TEMPLE MOUNT, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE, SOUTHERN STEPS, CITY OF DAVID, HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL**

We begin the day on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage proceeds down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove. We also visit the Church of the Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed before his arrest. We enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western (Wailing) Wall of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). On this site now stands the El-Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). From the temple area, we

make our way to St. Stephen's Gate to walk the Via Dolorosa, including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pool of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. A short walk takes us to stand on the original steps that Jesus climbed as he entered the Temple area. We then have a short walk to visit the City of David to view some of the amazing archaeological finds from the past several years. While in the City of David we take a walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel. Be sure to bring a flashlight as we make our

way through the dry tunnel. As we exit the tunnel, we visit the Pool of Siloam excavation site. We have dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 8 - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 21: BETHLEHEM, YAD VASHEM, RABBI'S TUNNEL**

This morning we drive to Bethlehem. We pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts and visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Next we make our way to Yad Vashem– the Jewish Holocaust Museum. Afterwards, we board our bus to take us back to the Western Wall and to tour the Rabbi's Tunnel. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 9 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22: SHRINE OF THE BOOK, MODEL CITY, GARDEN TOMB**

After breakfast, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. We see the fascinating 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. Afterwards we visit Golgotha and the Garden Tomb for worship and communion. We will have free time to shop in the old city in the afternoon with the potential to visit Elah Valley en route to our Farewell Dinner together. Then we have an evening transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A.

**DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 23: ARRIVE IN U.S.A.**

We arrive back in the U.S.A. today. At the close of an unforgettable tour, we take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.
